Optional Pre-booked Spiritual Excursions in 5 Major Ports

On this cruise we will make our pilgrim way from port to port reflecting on the **Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John** while exploring the spiritual richness of Eastern Orthodox Christian traditions. Spiritual Excursions have been arranged at several ports and are available as a pre-booked package. This price includes:

2 nghts Hotel in Greece with Breakfasts & Dinners; 1 ngt hotel Venice, on the Grand Canal, includes Breakfast. Package ALSO includes Pre-Booked Excursions as listed below.

“Sample” Pre-Booked Excursions Can Include:

1. **Greece**; full day in **Thessaloniki** to whose community Paul wrote two letters, & **Philippi** where Paul first preached the Gospel in Europe and where **Luke’s Gospel** has foundations.
2. **Istanbul**: Shore Excursion into the home city of **Eastern Christianity and the Ecumenical Patriarch** after having visited four key cities of Orthodoxy in Bulgaria, Romania and the Ukraine - time to give special attention to the Gospel of **Matthew**. Our excursion also includes a visit and guided tour of the **Blue Mosque and the Byzantine Church of St. Sophia**.
3. **Ephesus**: a full day visit to the home of **St. John the Evangelist and Mary, Mother of Jesus**; St. Paul’s home base for three years and city where the **Council of Ephesus** was held in 431. Includes visit to “old city” of Ephesus with it’s marble streets, library and much more.
4. **Alexandria**: Full day visit to this city in **Egypt** founded by *Alexander the Great* with special connections to **St. Mark’s Gospel**; the Jewish scriptures were first translated into Greek here; a city with a rich Coptic Christian heritage. Visit Roman Amphitheatre, Necropolis and Greco/Roman Museum.
5. **Venice**: Walking tour of **St. Mark’s Basilica**, where St. Mark is buried & **Murano Showroom**.
*** Optional visit to **Padua**, home of **St. Anthony**, to visit **Basilica, St. Anthony’s tomb and relics**.

Cruising is a great option for those clients who find it difficult to move from hotel to hotel on a land tour. We can include a pre and post stay to the main cruise itinerary as well as private spiritual excursions during your cruise.
